## WHAT IS MANAGING & SUPERVISING EMPLOYEES?

The course is designed for line managers with responsibility for supervision and management of employees using Woodworking Machinery and Equipment, to ensure that staff use them in a safe and legal manner.

All courses are tailored to the requirements of the individual and/or business needs.

## LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Regulation 9 (2) of Provision and Use of Work Equipment Regulations. Every employer shall ensure that any employee who supervises or manages the use of work equipment has received adequate training for the purpose of health and safety. This can also include the training in the methods which may be adopted when using work equipment, any risk which may occur and precautions to be taken.

Refresher training to be taken every 3 to 5 years to maintain personnel competency inline with current HSE guidance.

- Key machine operating procedures
- Existing guarding and current legislation and safe working practices
- All above aimed at practical applications on woodworking machinery
- Safety devices, including jigs
- Specific machine requirements
